DESCRIPTION

Thanks to its high wetting properties, high solid content and low viscosity, it's ideal to nourish, protect and decorate or restore terraces, providing resistance to water, weathering and foot traffic. The special pigmented versions grant a natural and uniform color-effect. Extremely easy application and maintenance (wide open time even in difficult climate conditions, no sanding required).

Enriched with UV filters and additives against wood harmful agents, it's the ideal solution for

any outdoor wooden surface.

APPLICATION FIELDS

Outdoor untreated wooden floors or previously treated with oils from the same range. Wooden terraces, piers, poolsides; garden furniture, outdoor wooden surfaces in general.

METHOD OF USAGE



Clean the surface to be treated by grease, silicones, old varnishes or traces of dirt; if possible, lightly sand.



Spread the product homogeneously with a brush, roller or rag, avoiding excesses.



Allow to dry for 6-8 hours.



Sanding is not normally required. If necessary, proceed with sanding with 180-220 grit sandpaper.



Apply at least a second coat.



Wait 24 hours for complete drying.

TECHNICAL RECOMMENDATIONS

The choice of a colored version ensures that the finish is considerably more resistant to ultraviolet rays than the transparent version of the same product.

In the case of saline water pools, it is strongly advisable to protect the surface with 1-2 coats of Deckin Oil HD.

Mix well before use.

To obtain a regular drying, apply uniform and not excessive thicknesses.

Oils are not compatible with different types of basecoats: it is therefore recommended to apply them on raw wood or on finishes previously obtained with oils from the same line. It is advisable not to apply under direct sun, on hot surfaces, in the presence of strong wind, rain, fog or with danger of night frosts.

Always perform a preliminary test on a sacrificial area to see if the effect matches the desired one.

The use on hard and / or exotic woods may result in a considerable lengthening of the drying times.

Always ensure adequate ventilation during and after application to facilitate the oxidation process and therefore allow a correct hardening of the applied oil layer.

Oils are subject to a physiological yellowing, both inside the container and once applied: it is a natural phenomenon related to the origin of the raw material.



STORAGE
